

Does Bahama have a solar power project?

The Bahamian government owns and manages property rooftops, parking lots and green spaces, on which solar power projects could be developed. Several projects that capitalize on that solar power potential are underway, Jones Bahamas points out.

Is solar a good option in the Bahamas?

On a kilowatt-hour (kWh) by kilowatt-hour basis, solar's your best, but you need to add battery energy storage capacity in order to reach higher levels of penetration," he noted. "Nassau's [the Bahamas' largest city] is a pretty big grid, and it can take a fair bit of solar without storage," Burgess continued.

Bahamian firm Lucayas Solar Power Ltd has started operation of its 6-MW Fairfield solar farm in the island of Grand Bahama, IDB Invest, a member of the Inter-American Development Bank, said on Tuesday.

Bahamas Solar and Renewables (BSR), a subsidiary of FOCOL, and Grand Bahama Power Company (GBPC), yesterday entered into a power purchase agreement (PPA) for BSR to provide five megawatts of solar electricity to Grand Bahama's grid, in a continued bid for GBPC to decrease its reliance on fossil fuels and to stabilize power costs on Grand Bahama.

Dave McGregor, Grand Bahama Power Company's president, said Bahamas Solar and Renewables 5 MW plant will be located separately from those being constructed by other independent power producer (IPP), Lucayas Solar Power. He said: "It's a 5 MW plant; a fairly standard solar plant. It will be located in the industrial area, which is actually ...

The government also plans to build utility scale solar power in the Family Islands. A PPA between BPL and the independent power producers for the Family Island projects is currently being finalized, she said, adding that the first groundbreaking ceremony is scheduled for early 2025.
