

Why is energy in Equatorial Guinea declining?

Energy in Equatorial Guinea is an industry with plenty of potential, especially in the fields of oil and natural gas. However, production has been declining in recent years due to under-investment and lack of new discoveries. In 2022, the country produced less than 100,000 barrels of oil per day (bopd) according to OPEC data.

Equatorial Guinea Total Energy Consumption. Energy consumption per capita is almost 2.1 toe, including 850 kWh of electricity (2022). Following a decrease in 2019, total energy consumption has increased significantly over the last few years (around 19%/year), reaching 3.5 Mtoe in 2022. Notably, there was a ten-fold increase in consumption from ...

Equatorial Guinea's domestic energy consumption is small - its population of around 1.75 million consumes only 4 percent of the country's oil output - which creates a sizeable surplus for exports. The country's location at an almost equal distance between the markets in Europe, Asia and North America gives it an additional advantage.

The Ceiba field and Okume complex are located in the Gulf of Guinea, in water depths ranging from 50m to 800m. Trident is the operator of the Block G producing-fields, while Kosmos operates the surrounding exploration acreage: Block S, Block W and Block EG-21.
