

Where is the Falkland Islands located?

The Falkland Islands (/ˈfɑː (l) klʔnd,ˈfʔlk -/FAW (L)K-lʔnd,FOLK-; [6]Spanish: Islas Malvinas [ˈislas malˈvinas]) is an archipelago in the South Atlantic Ocean on the Patagonian Shelf.

Are Falkland Islanders British?

Immigration from the United Kingdom,the South Atlantic island of Saint Helena,and Chile has reversed a population decline. The predominant (and official) language is English. Under the British Nationality (Falkland Islands) Act 1983,Falkland Islanders are British citizens.

What is the history of the Falkland Islands?

The history of the Falkland Islands (Spanish: Islas Malvinas) goes back at least five hundred years,with active exploration and colonisation only taking place in the 18th century. Nonetheless,the Falkland Islands have been a matter of controversy,as they have been claimed by the French,British,Spaniards and Argentines at various points.

Why are the Sanson islands called the Falklands?

Maps from this period show islands known as the Sanson islands in a position that could be interpreted as the Falklands. Sightings of the islands are attributed to Ferdinand Magellan or Estêvão Gomes of San Antonio,one of the captains in the expedition,as the Falklands fit the description of those visited to gather supplies.

Who landed the Falkland Islands?

The 12-man team,which landed some 40 kilometres (25 mi) from Stanley,was led by Juan José Lombardowho later,as Chief of Naval Operations,planned the 1982 invasion of the Falkland Islands. In November 1968,Miguel Fitzgerald was hired by the Argentine press to attempt a reprise of his 1964 landing.

Could Falkland Island be a conflict between Britain & Britain?

Since Britain's newly elected Labour Government banned similar oil projects in the United Kingdom,this created the prospect for a potential conflictbetween the Falkland Island's government and the British government.
