

What is Moldova's energy policy?

Moldova's energy policy focuses on improving integration in regional markets, strengthening energy security, improving compliance with EU directives, increasing electricity generation capacity and promoting energy efficiency and renewable energy.

How much energy does Moldova use?

Moldova imports 100% of its gas and coal consumption, nearly all of its oil consumption and around 80% of its electricity (including electricity procured from the Moldavskaya GRES [power station] situated in Transnistria). 1 Second, Moldova has obligations stemming from its aspirations for European integration.

Where does Moldova get its electricity from?

Moldavskaya GRES (MGRES) in the separatist region of Transnistria supplies the vast majority of the remaining 80 percent of electricity. Moldova also imports electricity from Ukraine and Romania. For years Moldova's natural gas consumption almost exclusively relied on Russian gas imports.

Does Moldova need a gas pipeline?

Once at full capacity in 2020, the pipeline is expected to supply almost all the gas Moldova consumes, but not that of the Transnistria region. The government also plans to diversify the energy mix with more renewable energy.

Is Moldova a member of the Energy Community?

Moldova has been a member of the Energy Community since 2010 and signed an Association Agreement with the European Union on 27 June 2014. It therefore had until December 2017 to make its legislation conform to the EU *acquis communautaire*, which

What are the sources of electricity and gas imports in Moldova?

The sources of electricity and gas imports are not diversified and crucially depend on gas supply from Russia and electricity supply from the Moldavskaya GRES power station, which operates beyond the control of the Moldovan government.

Moldova imports all of its supplies of petroleum, coal, and natural gas; until 2022, imports came largely from Russia.. Moldova was an observer to the treaty establishing the Energy Community from the outset (2006). Following its interest in full membership, the European Commission was mandated to carry out accession negotiations with Moldova in 2007.
