Pela primeira vez a empresa de electricidade EMAE, se prepara para produzir energia solar. Os primeiros 1270 pain is solares, para produ o de energia j  come aram a ser instalados.

S o Tom  e Pr ncipe est  a construir a primeira central de energia solar fotovoltaica. O arquip lago vai poder come ar a ter, dentro de alguns meses, energia el trica produzida a partir da luz solar e entrar na era de energias renov veis. Por enquanto, o dia-a-dia dos s o-tomenses   pautado por v rios cortes de energia.

Qual a pot ncia de um painel solar?  
Nesta primeira fase, que vai durar 5 meses, os pain es solares v o produzir energia com pot ncia de 0,5 megawatts. Na segunda fase, a central fotovoltaica atingir  o pico de 2 Megawatts.

S o Tom  e Pr ncipe vai ter uma nova central fotovoltaica para produzir mais 10 megawatts (MW) de energia, num projeto de 60,7 mil es de d lares, cofinanciados pelo Banco Mundial, Banco Africano de Desenvolvimento e Jap o, que inclui a instala o de tr s pequenas centrais na ilha do Pr ncipe.
