The Taylor, Duckworth, & Company Foundry, built 1884. Markham Vineyards, founded 1874.. St. Helena was first inhabited by a native American group known as the Wappo people. They spoke Yukian and are believed to have first settled in St. Helena as early as 2000 B.C. [10] The Wappo name for the area is Anakotanoma, meaning " Bull Snake Village ". [11]
