

Is Seychelles a country?

Seychelles[[c](#)]([/seʰeʰl \(z\)/\(i\),/seʰeʰl \(z\)/](#); French: [[sʰeʰl](#)]or [[seʰeʰl](#)]),officially the Republic of Seychelles(French: [R  publique des Seychelles](#); Seychellois Creole: Repiblik Sesel),is an island country and archipelagic state consisting of 155 islands (as per the Constitution) in the Indian Ocean.

The capital,Victoria,is situated on the island of Mah  . Seychelles Beach on the island of La Digue,Seychelles. Seychelles,one of the world's smallest countries,is composed of two main island groups: the Mah   group of more than 40 central,mountainous granitic islands and a second group of more than 70 outer,flat,coralline islands.
