What is separation of powers in Sierra Leone?

SEPARATION OF POWERS This is a distinguished political concept which has over the years been improved upon, modernised and re-introduced to the Sierra Leone Administrative Law system, as the country had always operated a system of separation of powers with Kings and Sub-Kings governing their respective territories and people ab initio.

Who holds supreme executive power in Sierra Leone?

Supreme executive power resides in the President and members of his cabinet in Sierra Leone. Judicial power, on the other hand, is vested with the judiciary, headed by the Chief Justice. Section 105 of the 1991 Constitution states that the Sierra Leone Parliament is the supreme law making body vested with legislative power.

Does Sierra Leone have an Anti-Corruption Commission?

Sierra Leone enacted an Anti-Corruption Act in 2000, under which an Anti-Corruption Commission was established.<sup>76</sup> This act was amended in 2008 to give more powers to the Commission.
