What is South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is a British overseas territory in the southern Atlantic Ocean. It is a remote and inhospitable collection of islands, consisting of South Georgia and a chain of smaller islands, known as the South Sandwich Islands.

How are the South Sandwich Islands managed?

The South Sandwich Islands, actively volcanic, consist of a 390-km-long chain of 11 main islands. It is a remote and inhospitable collection of islands, consisting of South Georgia and a chain of smaller islands known as the South Sandwich Islands. South Georgia is 165 kilometres (103 mi) long and 35 kilometres (22 mi) wide and is by far the largest island in the territory.

What happened to South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

In 1985, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands ceased to be administered as a Falkland Islands Dependency and became a separate territory. The King Edward Point base, which had become a small military garrison after the Falklands War, returned to civilian use in 2001 and is now operated by the British Antarctic Survey.

Where is South Georgia located?

The South Georgia Group lies about 1,390 kilometres (860 mi; 750 nmi) east-southeast of the Falkland Islands, at 54°S; 55°S; 36°W; 38°W. It comprises South Georgia Island itself, by far the largest island in the territory, and the islands that immediately surround it and some remote and isolated islets to the west and east-southeast.

Who owns South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The United Kingdom claimed sovereignty over South Georgia in 1775 and the South Sandwich Islands in 1908. The territory of "South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands" was formed in 1985; previously, it had been governed as part of the Falkland Islands Dependencies.

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South Georgia is situated 800 miles SE of the Falkland Islands. The main island of South Georgia is approximately 170 km long and between 2 and 40 km wide and occupies an area of 3,755 km², more than half of which is permanently ice covered. The coast is rich in wildlife and home to huge colonies of penguins, seals and albatross.

South Georgia Island is the largest of these islands, at about 167 kilometers (104 miles) long and ranging from 1.4 to 37 kilometers (0.0 to 23 miles) wide. All the islands combined cover an area of about 3,903 square kilometers (1,507 square miles).

South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands is at the northern limit of the krill distribution. Krill at South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands are not self-sustaining but dependent on the northerly movement of krill in the currents of the Southern Ocean from their spawning grounds under the ice in the Antarctic Peninsula and Weddell Sea.

Together, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands form part of the Scotia Arc, which extends from the tip of South America to Antarctica (and also includes the South Shetland and South Orkney Islands, though these are not part of the British dependency). The island of South Georgia is 105 mi (170 km) long, and about 25 mi (40 km) wide.

1 South Georgia Island is the only inhabited island, with the summer-only settlement of Grytviken, and the only one regularly visited by cruise ships. Minor islands are ranged along its north coast - those visited by cruises are Willis, Bird, Albatross and Prion, and Cooper. The south coast is exposed to raging winds and waves and is seldom visited - Annenkov is the only large island ...

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
