

Why should Tajikistan invest in hydropower?

Tajikistan's geographic proximity to some of the world's fastest-growing energy markets means that investing in developing its hydropower potential can contribute to regional energy security and the clean energy transition, in addition to addressing Tajikistan's high vulnerability to climate change and natural disasters.

What is the energy sector of Tajikistan?

The energy sector of Tajikistan includes several entities. The electric power is the responsibility of the State-owned joint stock company Barqi Tojik, which entirely controls production, transportation and distribution of electricity in Tajikistan.

What is green economy financing facility Tajikistan (Geff)?

In partnership with the European Union, Green Economy Financing Facility Tajikistan (GEFF) aims to enhance the competitiveness of the Tajik agricultural value chains. Grant support is available for primary agriculture and agri-businesses investing in high performing technologies.

Who is responsible for electricity production in Tajikistan?

The electric power is the responsibility of the State-owned joint stock company Barqi Tojik, which entirely controls production, transportation and distribution of electricity in Tajikistan. Oil and gas production, and development of oil and gas deposits are the responsibility of the State Committee for Oil and Gas.

Who is responsible for the distribution of natural gas in Tajikistan?

Distribution of natural and liquefied gas in Tajikistan is carried out by the national gas company TajikGas, while import and distribution of oil products are carried out by the State Company Tajikneftproduct. The coal-mining sector is controlled by the State Committee for Industry.

What is IEA's energy sector review of Tajikistan?

This International Energy Agency (IEA) energy sector review of Tajikistan was conducted under the auspices of the EU4Energy programme, which is being implemented by the IEA and the European Union, along with the Energy Community Secretariat and the Energy Charter Secretariat.

The Government of Tajikistan aims to transform itself from a net energy importer to a net energy exporter, on the strength of its potential for hydropower and solar power production. According to the World Bank, Tajikistan's power production is 92 percent hydropower, six percent hydrocarbon, and two percent from other sources.

The Pamir Energy Company was the first public-private partnership, which is a concession agreement to serve the GBAO autonomous region. The hydropower plant Sangtuda-1 was commissioned in 2009 and is operated by the Russian company, Unified Energy Systems. Sangtuda-2 was commissioned in 2011 and is operated by Iranian company, Sangob.

In addition, direct investments by Chinese companies in Tajikistan's energy sector reportedly amount to \$197
